Jeffrey Weisz, MD, is president and executive medical director for the Northwest Permanente Medical Group, a position he was appointed to by the board of directors in July 2011. Dr. Weisz also sits on the governing board of the national Permanente Federation's Executive Committee.

In his role, Dr. Weisz leads 1,300 Permanente physicians and clinicians who provide care to nearly 480,000 members of Kaiser Permanente in the Northwest Region.

Before joining Northwest Permanente, Dr. Weisz was the executive medical director and chairman of the board of the Southern California Permanente Medical Group. He began his career with Kaiser Permanente in 1978 as a staff hematologist/oncologist at the Panorama City, Calif. Medical Center. Dr. Weisz was appointed area medical director of Woodland Hills Medical Center in 1999.

Dr. Weisz received his medical degree from the Wayne State University School of Medicine in Detroit. He completed his internship and residency training at Henry Ford Hospital in Detroit. Dr. Weisz completed his fellowship in clinical hematology/oncology at the Los Angeles County-USC Medical Center. He is board certified in internal medicine and hematology. He also completed the Stanford Executive Program in 2003.
